3 The Parliament of Australia enacts:

4 **1 Short title**

5 This Act may be cited as the *Tax Laws Amendment (Small*
6 *Business and General Business Tax Break) Act 2009*.

7 **2 Commencement**

8 This Act commences on the day on which it receives the Royal
9 Assent.

16 **Guide to Division 41**

17 **41-1 What this Division is about**

18 You may be able to deduct an amount in relation to a depreciating
19 asset for the 2008-09, 2009-10, 2010-11 or 2011-12 income year if:
20 (a) you can deduct an amount for the decline in value
21 for the asset for the relevant year under
22 Subdivision 40-B; and

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- (b) you make certain new investments in respect of the asset in the period starting on 13 December 2008 and ending on 31 December 2009; and
- (c) the total of those new investments is at least \$1000 (for small businesses) or \$10,000 (for other businesses).

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Operative provisions

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Operative provisions

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41-5 Object of Division

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The object of this Division is to provide a temporary business tax break for Australian businesses using assets in Australia, with a view to encouraging business investment and economic activity.

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41-10 Entitlement to deduction for investment

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(1) You can deduct an amount for an income year in relation to an asset if:

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(a) the asset is a *depreciating asset, other than an intangible asset; and

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(b) you can deduct an amount under section 40-25 in relation to the asset for the income year; and

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(c) the income year is the 2008-09, 2009-10, 2010-11 or 2011-12 income year; and

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(d) the total of the *recognised new investment amounts for the income year in relation to the asset equals or exceeds the *new investment threshold for the income year in relation to the asset.

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- 1 (2) Subsection 73BA(7) of the *Income Tax Assessment Act 1936*
2 (deductions regarding assets used in research and development
3 activities) does not apply to a deduction under subsection (1).
- 4 (3) For the purposes of paragraph (1)(b), in determining whether you
5 can deduct the amount in relation to the asset under section 40-25
6 for the income year:
- 7 (a) disregard section 40-55 if the asset is a *car for which you
8 use the “12% of original value” method for that income year;
9 and
 - 10 (aa) disregard section 40-90 (reduction in cost where debt is
11 forgiven); and
 - 12 (ab) disregard subsection 40-365(5) (reduction in cost for
13 replacement asset where involuntary disposal); and
 - 14 (b) disregard Subdivision 328-D (capital allowances for small
15 business entities); and
 - 16 (c) disregard subsection 73BA(7) of the *Income Tax Assessment*
17 *Act 1936* (deductions regarding assets used in research and
18 development activities).

19 *Counting additional recognised new investment amounts for the*
20 *purposes of meeting the threshold*

- 21 (4) For the purposes of paragraph (1)(d), treat each of the following as
22 a *recognised new investment amount for the income year in
23 relation to the asset (the **relevant asset**):
- 24 (a) a recognised new investment amount for a previous income
25 year in relation to the relevant asset;
 - 26 (b) a recognised new investment amount for the income year or a
27 previous income year in relation to another asset, if:
 - 28 (i) the other asset is part of a set of assets including the
29 relevant asset; or
 - 30 (ii) the other asset is identical, or substantially identical, to
31 the relevant asset;
 - 32 (c) a recognised new investment amount for the income year or a
33 previous income year in relation to an asset *held by another
34 entity, if:
 - 35 (i) subsection 40-35(1) (jointly held depreciating assets)
36 applies in relation to the relevant asset because it is your
37 interest in an asset (the **underlying asset**); and
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- 1 (ii) the asset held by the other entity is the other entity's
2 interest in the underlying asset.

3 **41-15 Amount of deduction**

- 4 (1) The amount that you can deduct is:
5 (a) if the *new investment threshold for the income year in
6 relation to the asset is \$1000 (small business entities)—50%
7 of the total of the *recognised new investment amounts for
8 the income year in relation to the asset; or
9 (b) if paragraph (a) does not apply but subsection (3), (4) or (5)
10 applies—10% of that total; or
11 (c) otherwise—the sum of:
12 (i) 30% of the total of the recognised new investment
13 amounts for the income year in relation to the asset that
14 meet the condition in subsection (2); and
15 (ii) 10% of the total of the other recognised new investment
16 amounts for the income year in relation to the asset.
- 17 (2) A *recognised new investment amount meets the condition in this
18 subsection if:
19 (a) the *investment commitment time for the amount occurred
20 before 1 July 2009; and
21 (b) the *first use time for the amount occurred before 1 July
22 2010.
- 23 (3) This subsection applies if the income year is the 2011-12 income
24 year.
- 25 (4) This subsection applies if:
26 (a) you can deduct the amount because of paragraph 41-10(4)(a);
27 and
28 (b) the *new investment threshold for the income year in relation
29 to the asset exceeds the total of the *recognised new
30 investment amounts for the income year in relation to the
31 asset that meet the condition in subsection (2).
- 32 (5) This subsection applies if:
33 (a) you can deduct the amount because of paragraph 41-10(4)(b)
34 or (c); and

- 1 (b) the *new investment threshold for the income year in relation
 2 to the asset exceeds the sum of:
 3 (i) the total of the *recognised new investment amounts for
 4 the income year in relation to the asset that meet the
 5 condition in subsection (2); and
 6 (ii) the total of the amounts treated under paragraph
 7 41-10(4)(b) or (c) (as the case requires) as recognised
 8 new investment amounts for the income year in relation
 9 to the asset that meet the condition in subsection (2).

10 **41-20 Recognised new investment amount**

- 11 (1) An amount is a *recognised new investment amount* for the income
 12 year in relation to the asset if:
 13 (a) either:
 14 (i) the amount is included in the first element of the asset's
 15 *cost (worked out in accordance with
 16 Subdivision 40-C); or
 17 (ii) the amount is included in the second element of the
 18 asset's cost under paragraph 40-190(2)(a); and
 19 (b) the *investment commitment time for the amount occurs in
 20 the period:
 21 (i) starting at 12.01 am, by legal time in the Australian
 22 Capital Territory, on 13 December 2008; and
 23 (ii) ending on 31 December 2009; and
 24 (c) the *first use time for the amount occurs:
 25 (i) no later than the end of the income year; and
 26 (ii) no later than 31 December 2010; and
 27 (d) at the first use time for the amount, it is reasonable to
 28 conclude that you will use the asset principally in Australia
 29 for the principal purpose of *carrying on a *business; and
 30 (e) if the amount is included in the first element of the asset's
 31 cost—the first use time for the amount is the first time you or
 32 any other entity have used the asset, or have it installed ready
 33 for use, for any purpose; and
 34 (f) you have not been entitled to a deduction under this Division
 35 for any previous income year in relation to the amount.

- 1 (2) Treat the requirements in paragraph (1)(d) as *not* being met if, at
2 the first use time for the amount, it is reasonable to conclude that
3 the asset will never be located in Australia.
- 4 (3) For the purposes of paragraph (1)(e), disregard any previous use of
5 the asset that was merely for the purposes of reasonable testing or
6 trialling.
- 7 (4) Treat the requirements in paragraph (1)(e) as *not* being met if the
8 amount becomes included in the first element of the asset's *cost at
9 a time because of paragraph 40-205(a) (splitting depreciating
10 assets) or 40-210(a) (merging depreciating assets).
- 11 (5) In determining the amount of a *recognised new investment
12 amount, disregard:
- 13 (a) subsection 40-90(2) (reduction in cost where debt is
14 forgiven); and
- 15 (b) paragraph 40-365(5)(a) (reduction in cost for replacement
16 asset where involuntary disposal).

17 **41-25 Investment commitment time**

- 18 (1) The *investment commitment time* for the amount is:
- 19 (a) if the amount is included in the first element of the asset's
20 *cost—the time at which you:
- 21 (i) enter into a contract under which you *hold the asset at
22 that time, or will hold the asset at a later time; or
- 23 (ii) start to construct the asset; or
- 24 (iii) start to hold the asset in some other way; or
- 25 (b) if the amount is included in the second element of the asset's
26 cost—the time at which you enter into a contract, or start
27 construction, for the economic benefit in relation to which
28 the amount becomes, or will become, included in that
29 element under paragraph 40-190(2)(a).

30 *Integrity rule*

- 31 (2) Subsection (3) applies in relation to an amount if:
- 32 (a) at a time, you:
- 33 (i) enter into a contract under which you *hold an asset at
34 that time, or will hold the asset at a later time; or

- 1 (ii) start to construct an asset; or
2 (iii) start to hold an asset in some other way; and
3 (b) at a later time, you engage in conduct that results in you:
4 (i) entering into a contract under which you hold the asset
5 mentioned in paragraph (a) (or an identical or
6 substantially similar asset) at that later time, or will hold
7 that asset (or an identical or substantially similar asset)
8 at an even later time; or
9 (ii) starting to construct an asset that is identical or
10 substantially similar to the asset mentioned in
11 paragraph (a); or
12 (iii) starting to hold the asset mentioned in paragraph (a) (or
13 an identical or substantially similar asset) in some other
14 way; and
15 (c) you engage in that conduct for the purpose, or for purposes
16 that include the purpose, of becoming entitled to a deduction
17 under this Division.
- 18 (3) Despite paragraph (1)(a), the *investment commitment time* for an
19 amount to which that paragraph would otherwise apply is the time
20 mentioned in paragraph (2)(a).
- 21 (3A) For the purposes of paragraph (1)(a) and subsection (2), treat
22 yourself as having started to construct an asset at a time if you first
23 incur expenditure in respect of the construction of the asset at that
24 time.
- 25 (3B) For the purposes of paragraph (1)(b), treat yourself as having
26 started construction for an economic benefit at a time if you first
27 incur expenditure in respect of the construction for the benefit at
28 that time.
- 29 *Options*
- 30 (4) To avoid doubt, for the purposes of this section, you do not enter
31 into a contract under which you *hold an asset merely because you
32 acquire an option to enter into such a contract.

33 **41-30 First use time**

34 The *first use time* for the amount is:

- 1 (a) if the amount is included in the first element of the asset's
- 2 *cost—the time at which you start to use the asset, or have it
- 3 *installed ready for use; or
- 4 (b) if the amount is included in the second element of the asset's
- 5 cost—the later of:
- 6 (i) the time at which it becomes included in that element
- 7 under paragraph 40-190(2)(a); or
- 8 (ii) the time mentioned in paragraph (a).

9 **41-35 New investment threshold**

10 The *new investment threshold* for an income year (the *relevant*

11 *income year*) in relation to an asset means:

- 12 (a) \$1000 if you are a *small business entity during any of the
- 13 following income years:
- 14 (i) the income year in which occurs the *investment
- 15 commitment time for any *recognised new investment
- 16 amount for the asset in relation to the relevant income
- 17 year;
- 18 (ii) the income year in which occurs the *first use time for
- 19 any such amount;
- 20 (iii) the relevant income year; or
- 21 (b) otherwise—\$10,000.
